### Ap. Jeshher Cardoso

On the first week of May we had the more than blessed presence of Ap. Jeshher Cardoso, de São Paulo, who is our spiritual covering. He stayed two days with us, ministering about the restoration of the fivefold ministries, spiritual covering and fatherhood. Besides that, he challenged us to go to the *Imersão Total* Conference in São Paulo to talk about the *Flechas Project*, which he adopted as the official Missions' School for the Covenant Apostolic Network, which we're a part of.

We went with our group to Quissamã, in the northeast region

of Rio de Janeiro state, for a weekend, to help the *Igreja Apostólica Tenda da Adoração*, from ps. Elias. On Saturday we walked around the city sharing the gospel. We also visited a museum where there was a piano, and we also worshiped there. We were the first Christian group that played and sang on that place – it was an unforgettable moment!

Later that evening we shared about the Persecuted Church, since it was the Persecuted Church Sunday, promoted by Open Doors.

Those were days of great blessing for all of us, and will always be in our hearts
